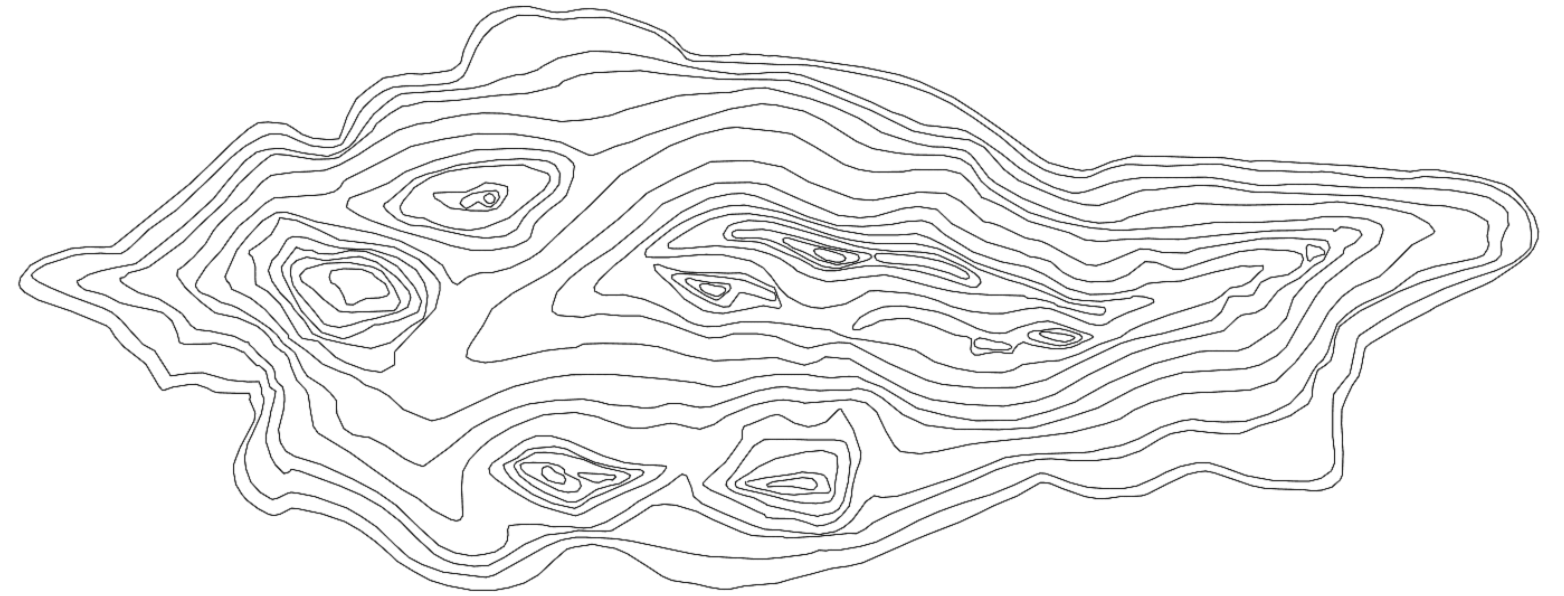
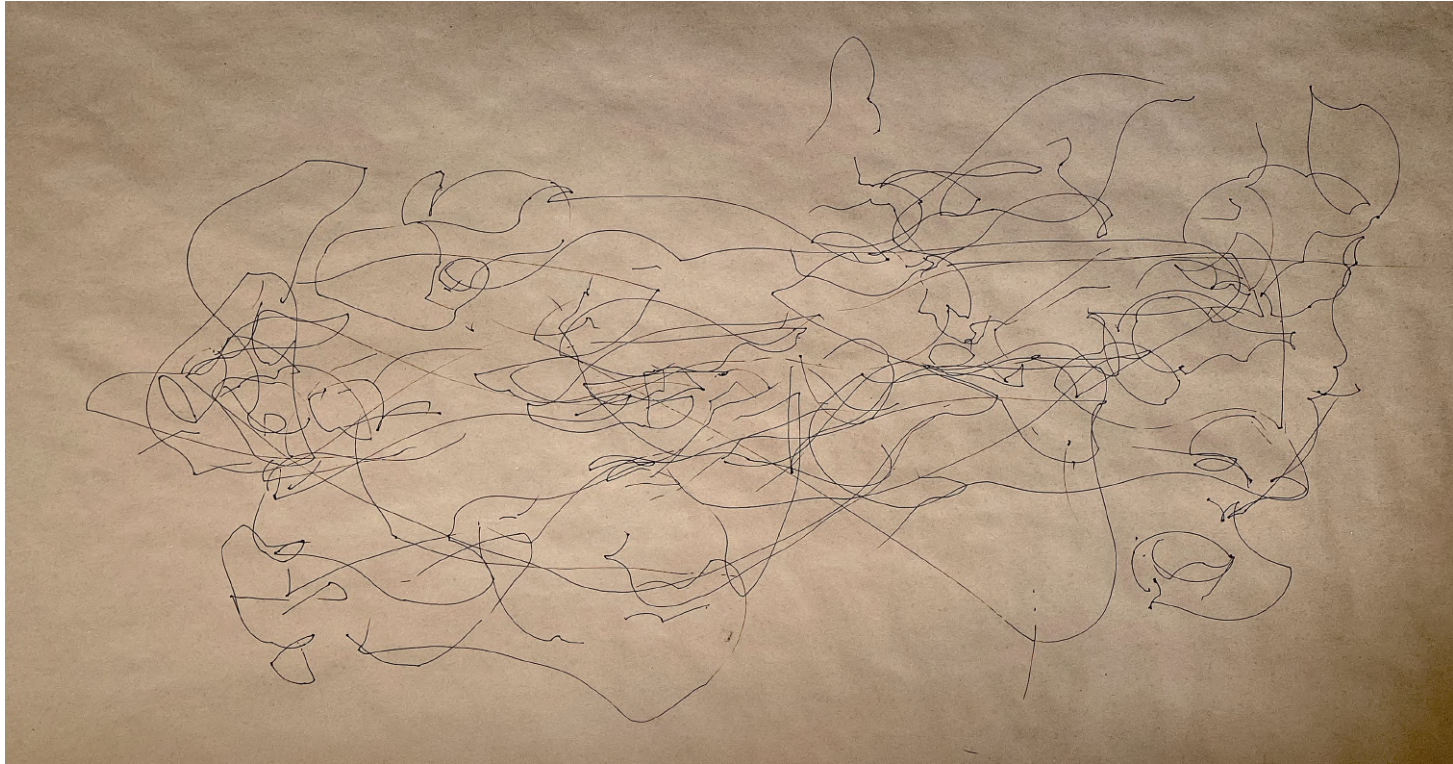

The original drawing was created using my body, a sharpie and string. Keeping my arm outstretched at a right angle with a long string tied to my index finger, and a sharpie tied to the string, I walked around the piece of paper 100 times. Due to the constraints of the room and inconsistencies of the human body, the sharpie created irregular pendulum-like marks.

I chose endurance as the theme for the site and traced out dramatic topography from the original drawing. I settled on a site that was four miles long with an elevation change of 750'. I used my original drawing to find pathways that would circulate visitors throughout the site utilizing different forms of endurance. Sun mapping on the site revealed areas with temperatures that would be most conducive for gathering spaces as well as areas that should be avoided.
